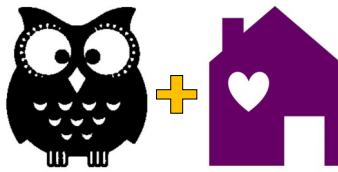

complete your
KSU application

Visit admissions.kennesaw.edu/ to check admission requirements to attend KSU. If eligible, then you can complete the online application. If you are on free and reduce lunch, have your high school send an official Application Fee Waiver directly to KSU Admissions. If needed, KSU Admission can supply a paper application

Test Scores
